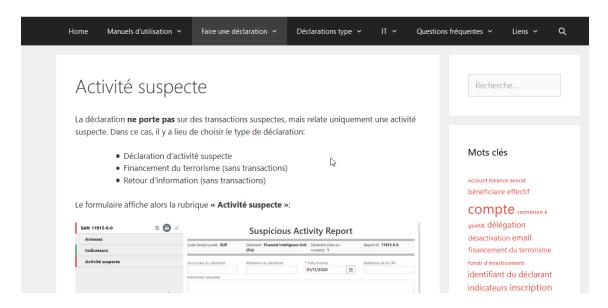

Feedback from Reporting Entities

- Too many windows
- Certains fields are difficult to fill in or redundant
- Not enough pop-ups with useful indications
- Complicated structure

goAML Web 2021

The **online form** used to fill out reports has been improved

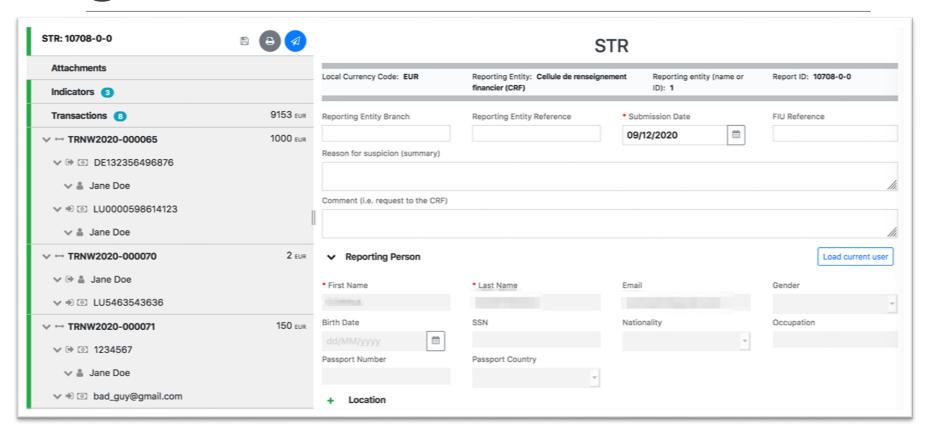
- More modern look and feel
- More intuitive to use
- Better overview
- Improved navigation

goAML Web 2021

New features:

- Saving incomplete reports (even invalid ones)
- Drag & Drop of attachments
- Import / export of transactions in XML form

Known Issues

For some issues a fix is included in upcoming version 4.8:

- Empty report type dropbox
 - Workaround: click again or refresh the webpage
- Weird special characters after transaction XML import
 - Workaround: correct the impacted fields in the web form before submitting the report

Currently open issues:

Sometimes « undo delete » has no effect, without a reason being indicated

goAML 5.0

goAML 5.0 is set to be released in July 2021 by UNODC

→ upgrade 5.0 by FIU in 2021-Q4 with a transition period

goAML 5.0

Major changes:

- Look and feel goAML Web (other menu items)
- XSD schema changes
- SAR / STR mix
- Entity-entity relationships



→ IT developments by reporting entities in order to adapt the XML files

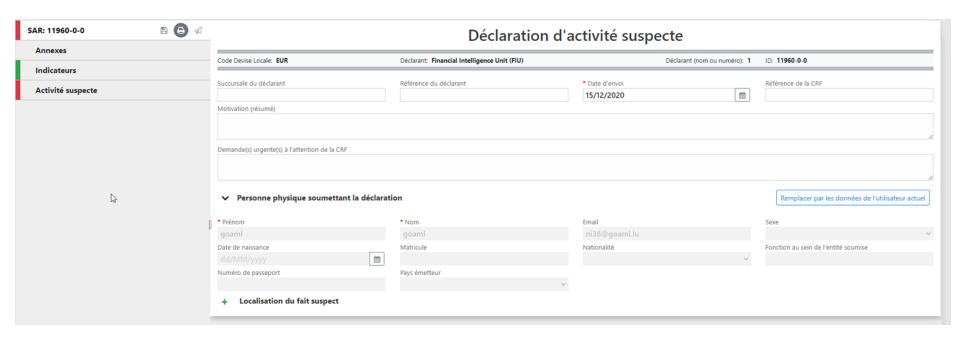

Filling out a Suspicious Activity Report (SAR)

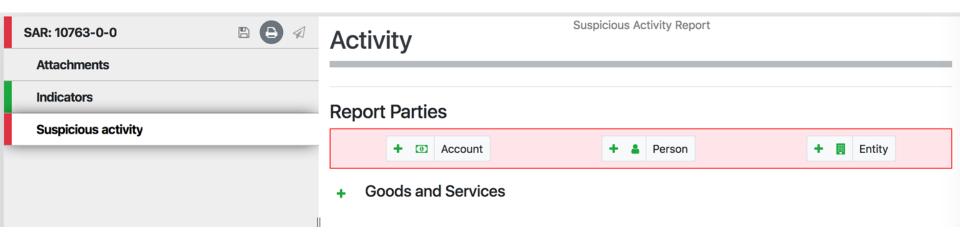
The report does not concern suspicious transactions, but a suspicious activity only.



Suspicious Activity Report

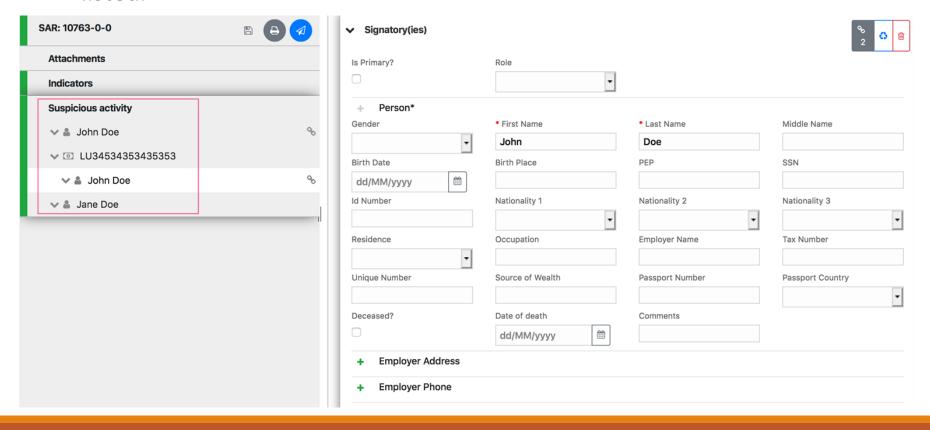
The Reporting Entity must indicate one or multiple « Report Parties » related to the suspicion.

Example A suspect - John Doe is an account owner.



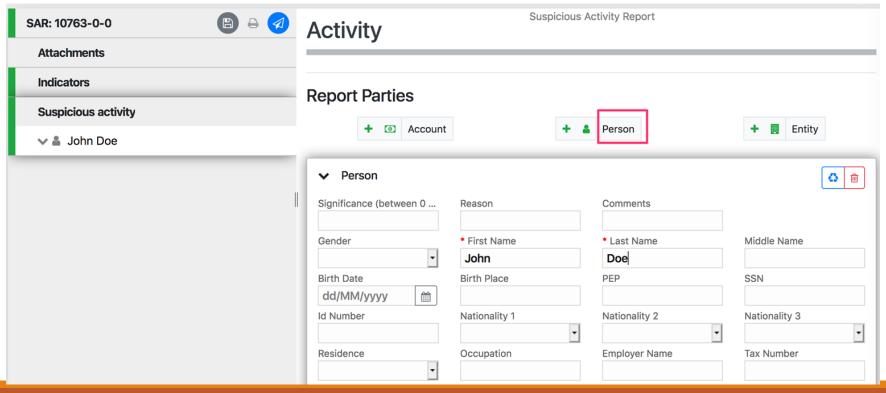
Navigation panel

In the left panel the persons, entities or account that you report are listed.



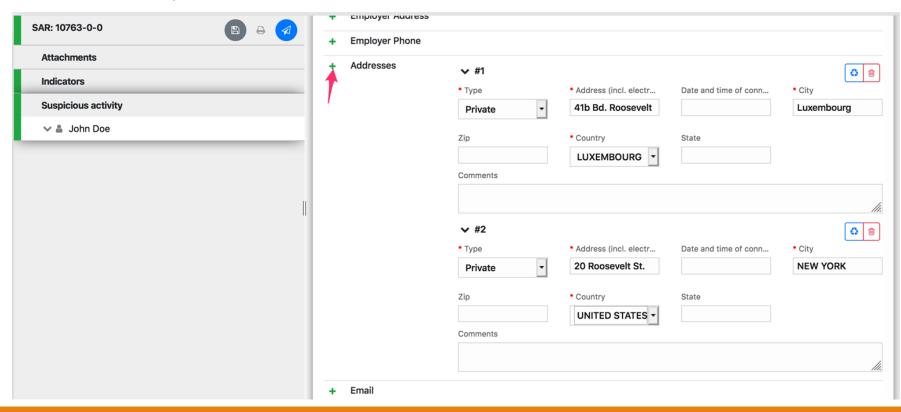
SAR - Input multiple persons

You can fill in multiple Persons, Entities or Accounts. After filling in the details for one object, you must return to « Report Parties » and **click on the text(!)** « Account », « Person » or « Entity»



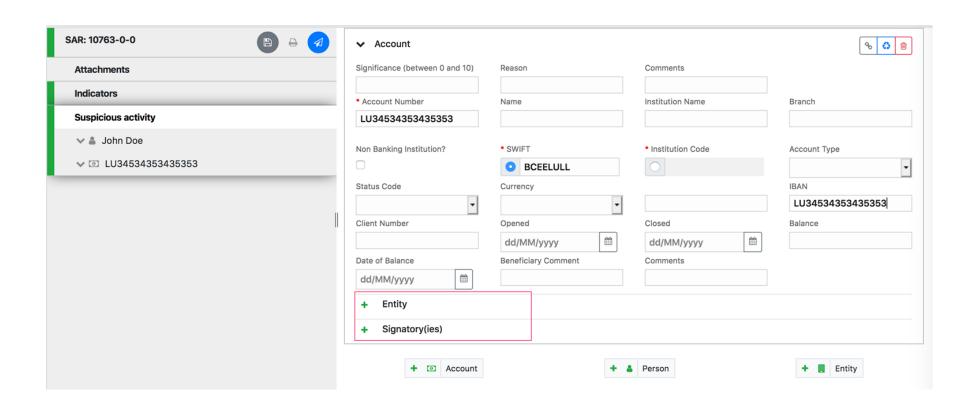
SAR - Input multiple addresses

It is possible to fill in one or multiple addresses (by clicking the + button)



SAR – Fill out an account

Account filled in - adding an account owner:



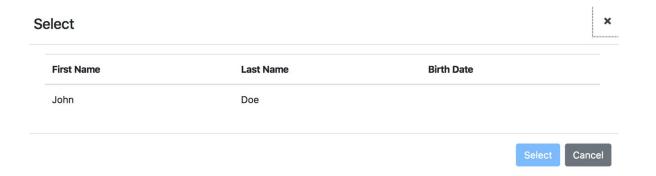
SAR – Reuse existing data

You can use a person already entered - in our example John Doe - as account owner for LU343564564:

2) Select the person from the list:

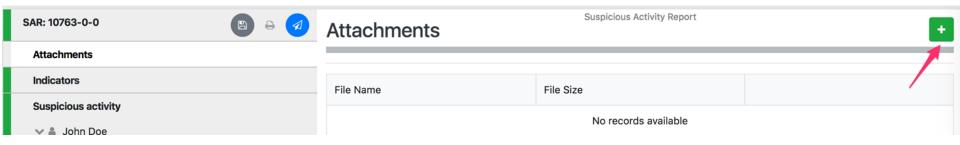


SAR – Why reuse existing data?

- Faster
- Whenever you add more detail to one element, all linked occurrences of the element will be updated automatically
- The « reuse » feature exists for
 - Persons
 - Entities
 - Accounts

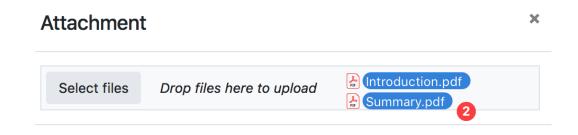
Attachments

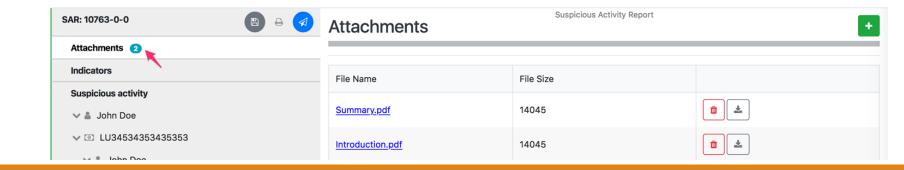
- At any given moment, it is possible to attach files to the report.
- In order to use this functionality, you must choose Attachments in the left panel and click on + in the upper right of the screen.



Attachments

It is now possible to upload **multiple files** at once: either select them or drag & drop them to the gray area, then click "Upload".

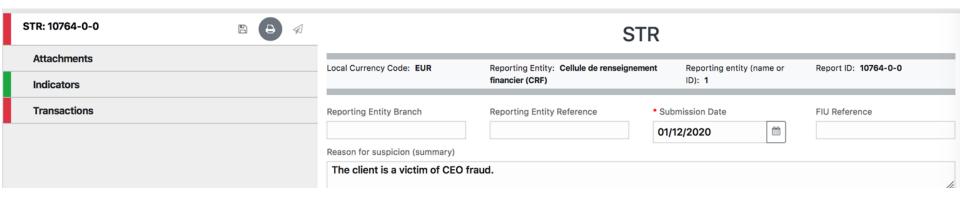




Fill out a Suspicious Transaction Report (STR)

The report contains one or multiple suspicious transactions.

Example: a report in which your client was a victim of *CEO fraud*.



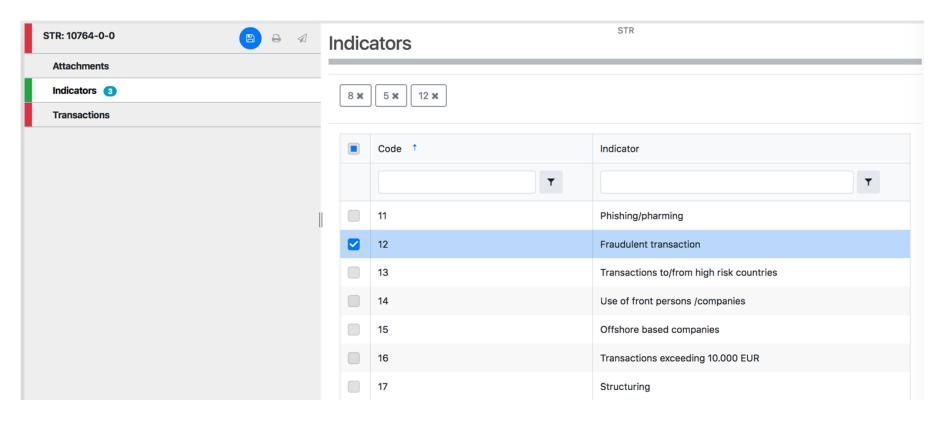
Suspicious transaction report use case scenario

CRFBank reports that their client, Mister John Doe was a victim of CEO fraud.

The transaction of 1000 EUR with value date 1st of November 2020 has been executed from his bank account LU1234567890000000 held at CRFBank (CRFLULLL) to the Luxembourgish bank account LU0000111122223333 held at PARQUETLUL, account owner Jane Doe.

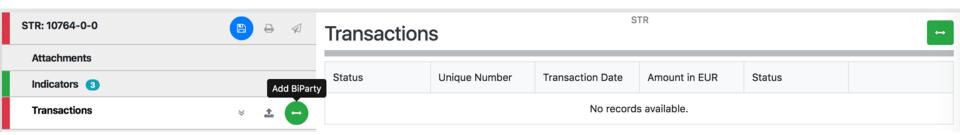

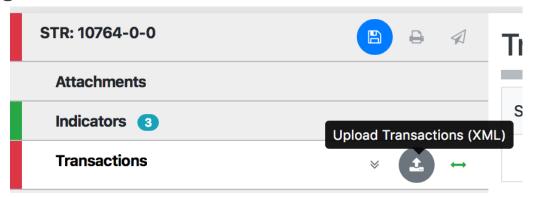


Adding transactions

By entering a transaction in the Web interface:



Uploading transactions as XML file



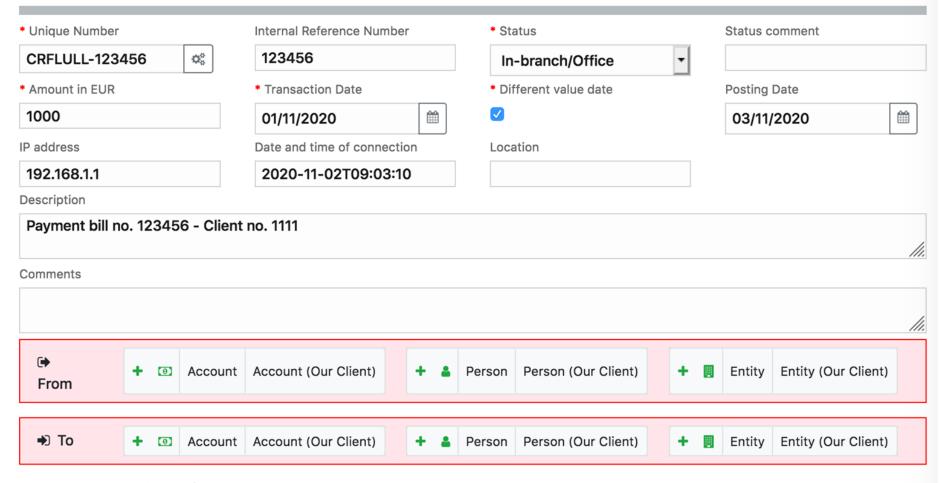
On transactions

Each transaction must have:

- a general part
- a « From » part the source of the funds (debit side)
- a « To » part the destination of the funds (credit side)

Transaction





+ Goods and Services

Object types

A transaction must always have the two parts filled in, « From » and « To » an *object*.

The three object types are:

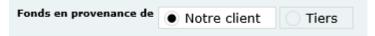
- Account
- Person
- Entity



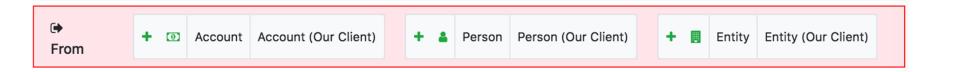
Our client

If the funds come from an account of a client of the Reporting Entity and that this account is related to the report, choose « Account (Our client) »

In the previous version of GoAMLWeb the concept of Our Client/Third Party was represented as such:



In the new version:

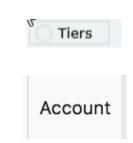


Our client



Their meaning stays unchanged:

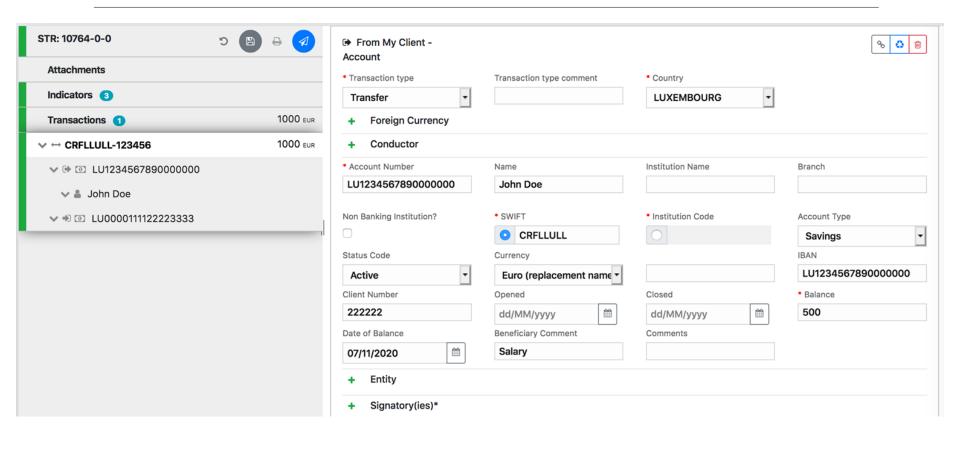
The account is <u>both</u> held with the Reporting Entity **and** the person in relation to the account is a relevant person (e.g. victim) or a suspect in connection with the report.



- The account is not held with the Reporting Entity.
- The account is held with the Reporting Entity but there is no link with the report/suspicion.

Note: The condition of validity of a transaction requires that "Out Client" be filled in on one side **or** the other.

Complete transaction

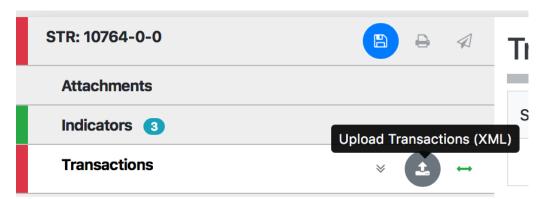


TRANSACTIONS - Import XML

It is possible to upload and download as an XML file with partially or fully complete transactions.

It is not necessary to have filled in a complete or valid transaction in order to upload or download it.

This feature allows the user to easily reuse information and visually verify in the Web interface that the transactions are complete before submitting them to the CRF.

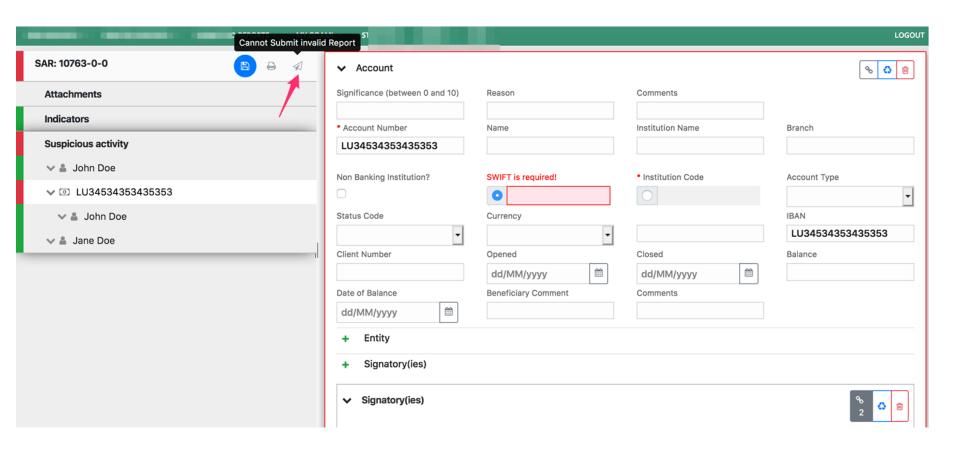


Complete report

- The report is complete when all the sections in the left panel are green.
- The red color signals that a section is not complete, mandatory information is missing.

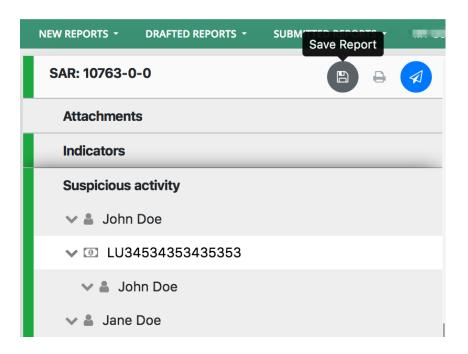
An incomplete report cannot be sent to the CRF.

On the other hand, a report can be *saved* at any moment. This gives the users the possibility to enter information, even incomplete, as a first step.



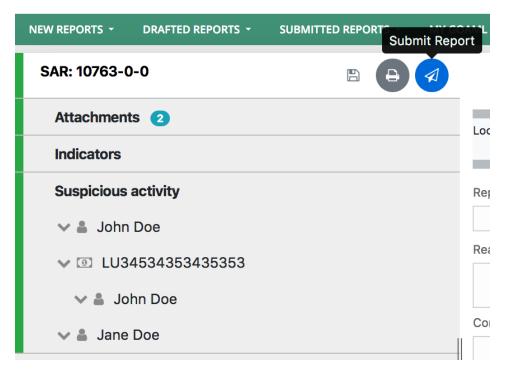
Save regularly

The report is not automatically saved, you must save regularly in order not to lose the filled in data.



Submit a report

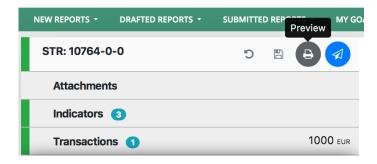
When the report is complete, it is possible to submit the report to the CRF.
