Timeline

goAML – from 4.8.5 to 5.0.05

CRF first introduced goAML, in version 4.2 on the 1 January 2017

goAML 4.8.5 live at CRF since August 2021

goAML 5.0 was published by UNODC mid 2021

CRF presentation to our XML-reporting entities in November 2021, announcing the new XSD schema

Go live 5.0.05 on **2 September 2022**



Major new features

goAML 5.0 – Hybrid reports



Hybrid reports


For example:

- A person and/or entity is linked to the report, but not directly to any transaction that you wish to report.
 - ➤ Report the transaction and then under « Suspicious activity », you can report the person and/or entity
- A person and/or entity has multiple accounts. Only some accounts have transacted.
 - ➤ Indicate the non-transacted accounts under « Suspicious activity »

Entity to entity relationships




goAML 5.0 – Entity to entity

Warning:


goAML Web can only handle one level of related entities.

In order to avoid potential issues with the validity of the report, only report one relationship per entity!

Don't: (B has 2 relationships!)



Minor new features

goAML 5.0 - Other features

- Security enhancements
- Web Forms styling update for accessibility
- > Elements can be hidden from the Web forms
- > All Home and Help pages are now translatable in different languages
- ➤ Support for XSD 1.1 assertions 2nd phase


goAML 5.0 - Other features

- > Switch between delegating entities without logging out and back in
- ➤ Size limit for report raised from 20 MB to 30 MB (Exception: SARe/STRe)
- Name of the user is shown in user change management grids
- Currencies XAG, XPD, XPT are available


Delegation – switch RE

Impacts on web reporting

Impacts on web reporting

- ☐ All reports of transaction type (STR, TFTR, RIRT) will become hybrid type reports allowing transaction elements along with activity elements
- ☐ Reason, comments, description,... from 4000 -> 8000 characters
- ☐ New entity-to-entity relationship types:

Director / Manager
Domiciliation agent
Accountant
Shareholder
Transfer agent
Depository bank
Alternative Investment Fund Manager
General Partner
Limited Partner

- ☐ Fields for Person, Account, Entity are ordered differently according to their importance
- Hidden fields
- Mandatory fields

Unused/hidden fields

- Some fields are of little use during analysis
- Some fields are rarely correctly used -> more confusing than helpful
- Less fields will be
 - ☐ visible in the web forms
 - \square available in the XSD (by means of maxoccurs = 0) 2^{nd} phase
- ☐ 2nd phase this breaks backward compatibility
 - ☐ Which is why we waited for the update to 5.0 to hide these fields in the XSD
 - only few were (rarely) filled out by reporting entities

Which elements are hidden?

Non-exhaustive list:

- ➤ a lot of **comments** (on address, phone, to_funds_comment, transmode_comment, etc)
- ➤ Person Person my client
 - Id number
 - Tax reg number
 - Source of wealth

....

Mandatory fields

- Person My Client
 - Birth Date
- Entity My Client
 - Incorporation Country Code
- Account / Account My Client
 - Account Holder Name

2nd phase - Asserts

(NEW RESTRICTIONS)

New checks

- by REGEX or other means
- for data quality improvement
- formalizes the rules already specified on our FAQ

New checks

Examples:

- ☐ Is this IBAN really an IBAN?
- □ Is the incorporation code of this Luxembourgish company correctly formatted? (B123456 Not B000123456, nor 123456, nor B 123456...)
- ☐ A report shall not have more than 500 transactions
- **...**


Example assertion in XSD 1.1

For particular report types (STR, SAR), reason for suspicion must be indicated (optional for other report types):

```
<xs:assert test="if (report_code = ('STR','SAR')) then string-length(reason) gt 0
else true() " xerces:message="REJ10: For particular report types (STR, SAR),
reason for suspicion should be mandatory"/>
```

Submitting a report

If the report is not valid against new asserts (2nd phase), once you click submit the web report, you get a pop up containing the error messages:



Summary

Timeline - Recap


We will go live with goAML 5.0 with an XSD "light", with no assertions or other restrictions, for 6 months.

Go live 5.0 on 2 September 2022

The new possibilities can be used as soon as we go live, in the XML files as well as in the Webforms. The mentioned fields will be immediately hidden/made mandatory, but only on the Webforms.

After 6 months, we will apply the assertions and other restrictions to the XSD – beginning of **March 2023** (breaking backward compatibility)

goAML Training – 5.0


As goAML Training already has version 5.0 with asserts and restrictions, you can create test reports already.

Requests to REs

Request – pending user requests

In order to avoid problems with the upgrade to version 5.0, we ask the reporting entities to finalize and/or reject all pending user requests in goAML Web - https://faq.goaml.lu/manuels-dutilisation/menu-administration/demandes-en-attente-util/:



Before the upgrade, all new user requests that have not been finalized will be rejected. The user can register again in version 5.0

Request - Drafts

In order to avoid problems with the upgrade to version 5.0, we ask the reporting entities to clean up their draft reports by either finishing and sending them or deleting them on the morning of 2 September at the latest.

Outlook on 5.1, 5.2, ...

goAML 5.1 -> released in February 2022

Contains new possibilities for report, account and transaction nodes:


- "Mobile phone" accounts

Contains new possibilities for person, entity and address nodes



- * Keep in mind that it is also possible to generate transaction-only XML files that compliance officers can upload while filling in a manual report.
- An XML file can be checked before upload by using the XML Report Validator in goAML. This is also the place where you can download the currently used XSD in the environment (training or production).
